Title: Possession of Weapons in Fire Department Facilities

Purpose: To establish a procedure for the safety of all employees that will control the use of weapons, such as guns, within any Fire Department facility.

Scope: This policy is designed to outline where Fire Department employees may possess gun/firearm while on duty with regards to all Fire Department facilities.

General: Only authorized personnel will be allowed to have a gun/firearm in their possession while on duty at any City of Winter Park Fire Department facility. Personnel that are authorized to have guns/weapons will keep them holstered at all times.

100.11.01 Weapons in the Fire Station

Authorization for any Fire Department employee to possess a gun/weapon within any Fire Department facility must be granted by the Fire Chief, in writing, through the Chain-of Command.
