**Purpose:** To establish policy that will require a particular type of identification be carried by all Department personnel for Emergency Medical Certification.

**Scope:** This action will cover all employees who are required to maintain a level of Emergency Medical Certification.

**General:** All Fire Department EMTs and Paramedics are required to carry the below listed identification as outlined in State Statute 10D-66.56 and 10D66.57, while on duty. In addition all employees are required to carry on their person an Orange County certification card.

1. 10D66.56 Emergency Medical Technician
  - (2) Responsibilities
    - f. Must carry the following items while on-duty
      - (I) EMT Certification card or copy thereof
      - (II) American Heart Association Cardiopulmonary Basic Rescue Certification card or copy thereof
2. 10D66.57 Paramedic
  - (2) Responsibilities
    - d. Carry the following while on-duty
      - (I) Paramedic State Certification Card or copy thereof
      - (II) American Heart Association Cardiopulmonary Basic Rescue Certification card or copy thereof
      - (III) EMS "Green Card" for presentation to doctors at the scene
